The Clear Lake Symphony will hold a competition on January 12, 2019 for young artists from Houston area high schools, junior highs, and elementary schools. The winners are provided with a scholarship and the opportunity to perform with the Symphony. The winners will perform on the March 22nd concert in 2019.
